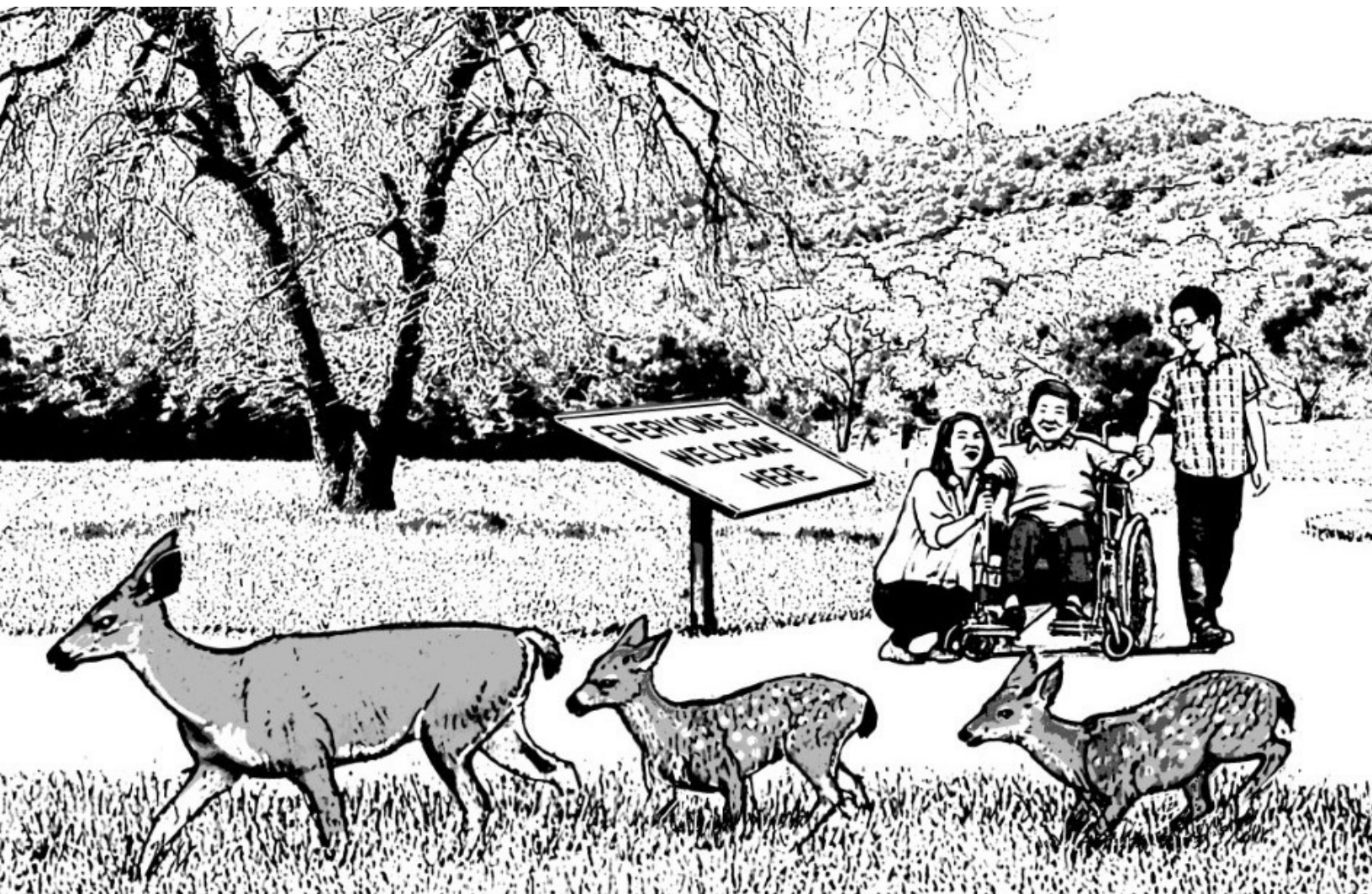




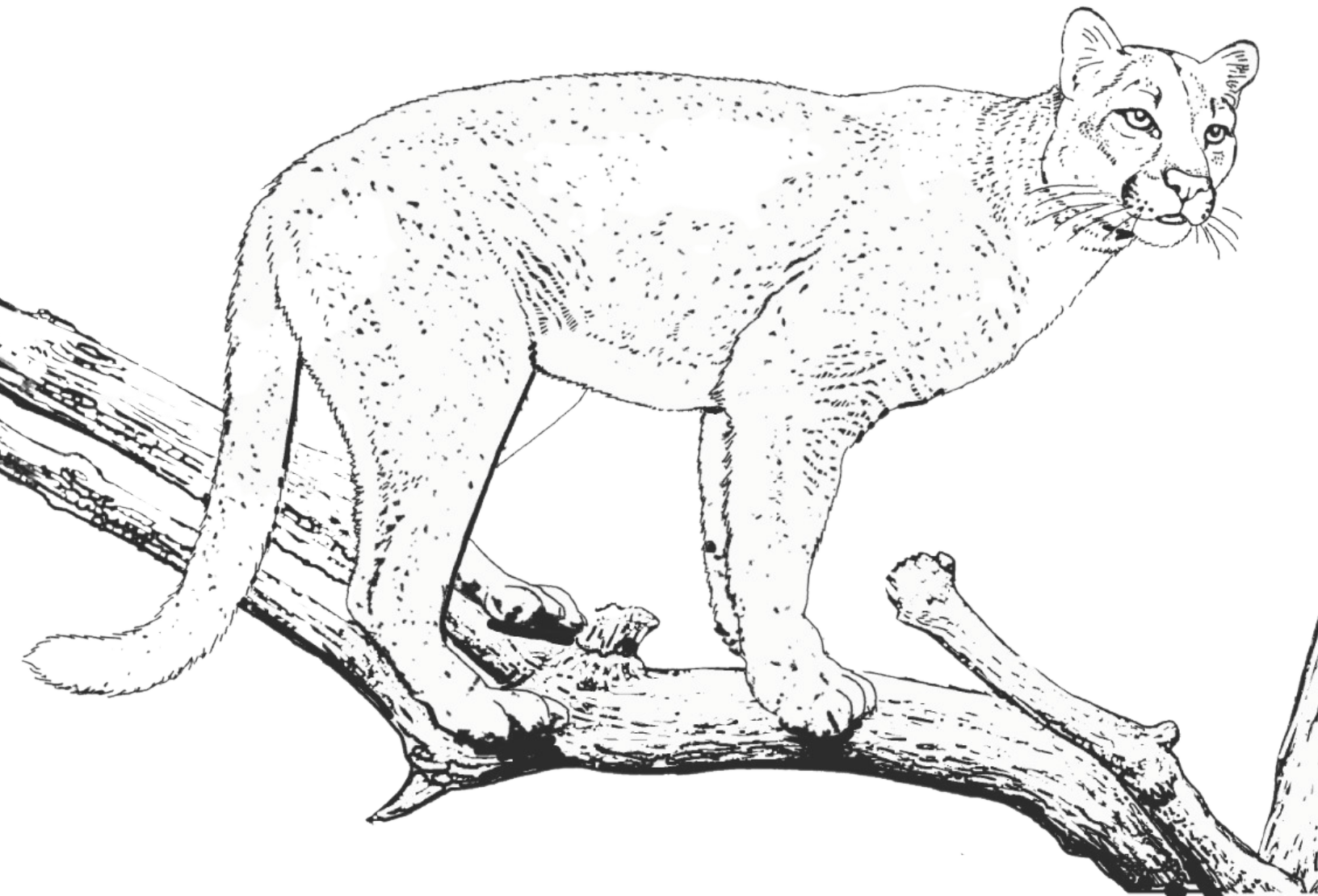

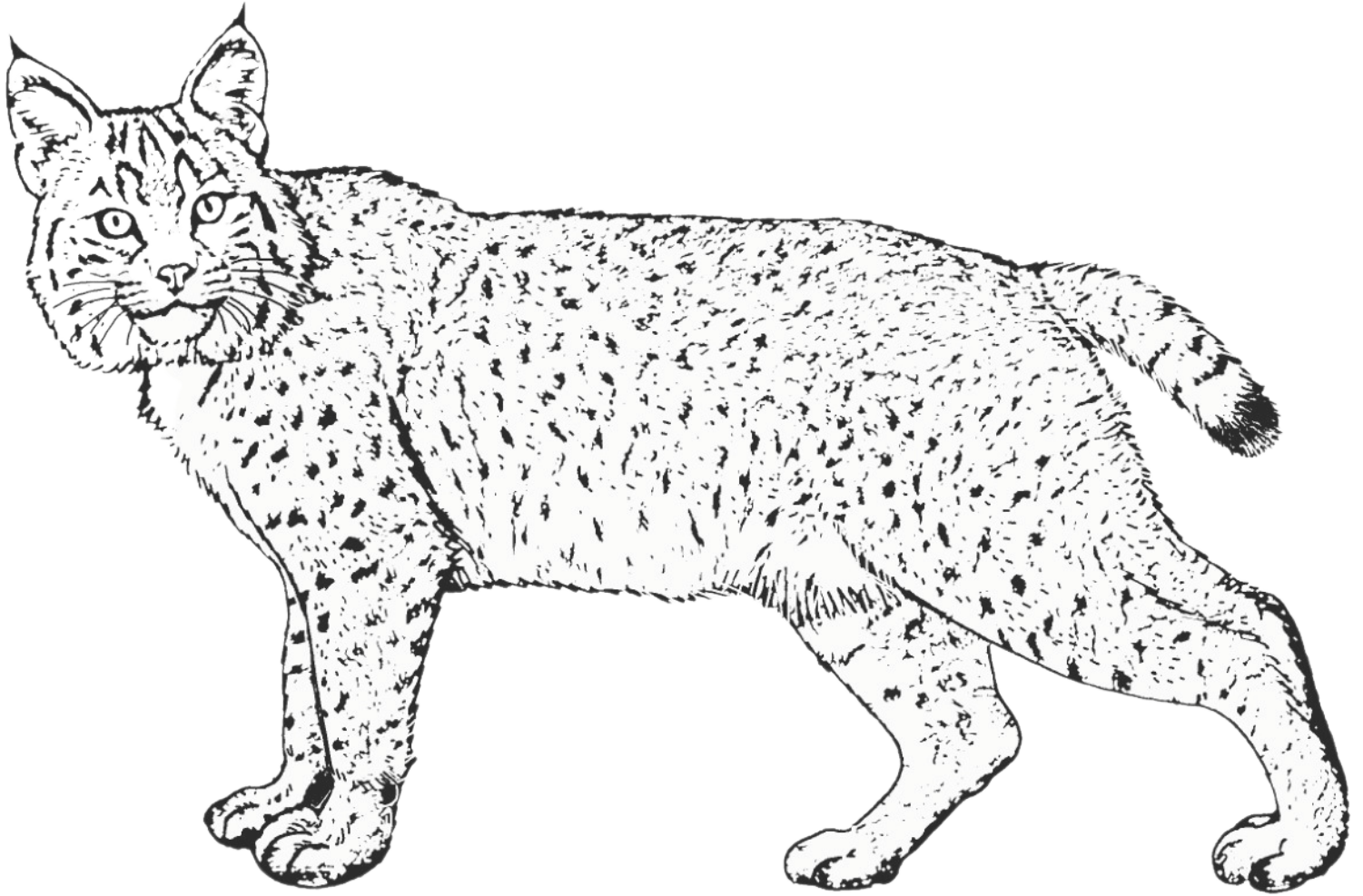


COLOR THE MOUNTAIN LION

and can weigh over 120 pounds.

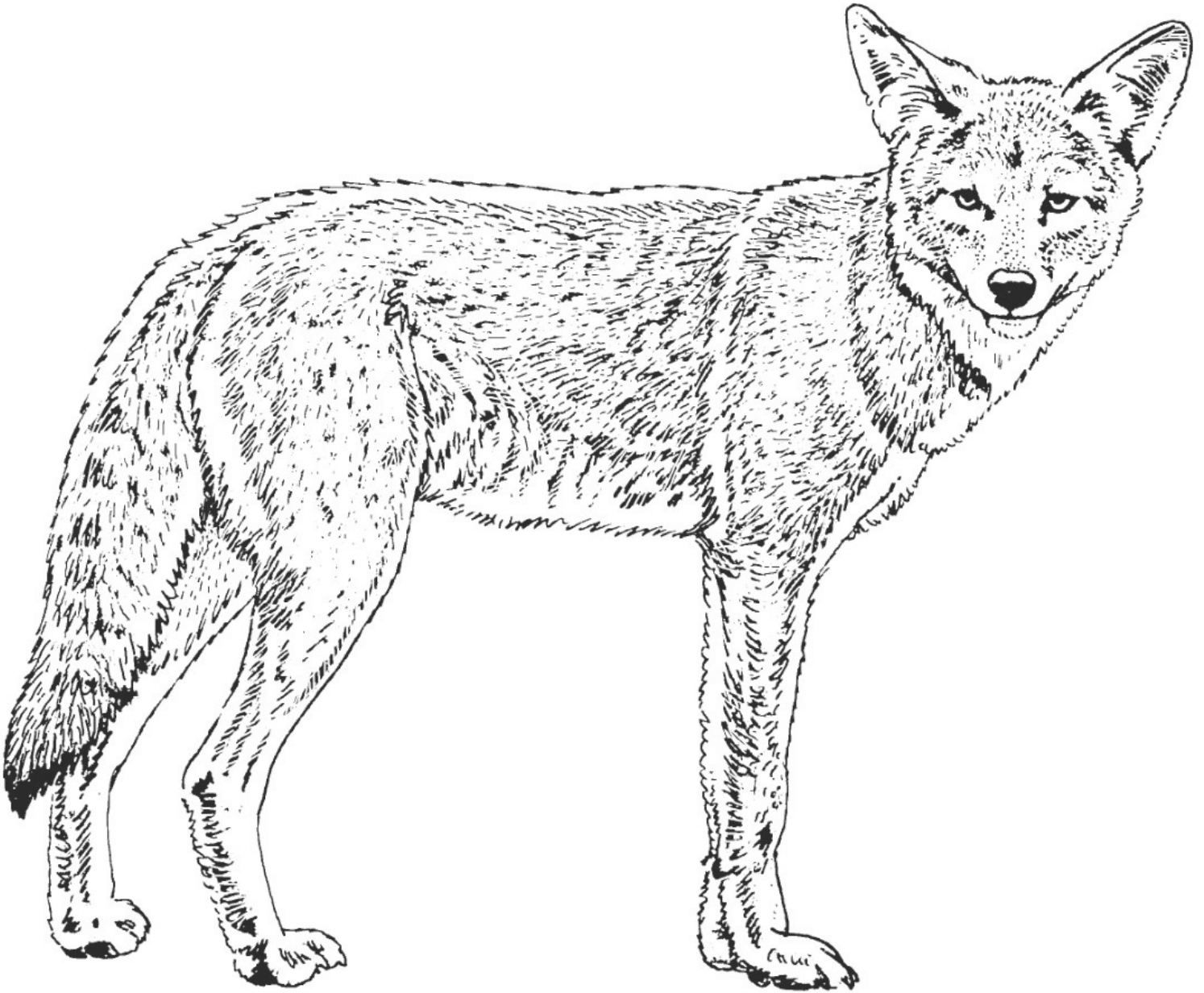


COLOR THE BOBCAT



Bobcats live alone and weigh 20 to 30 pounds.

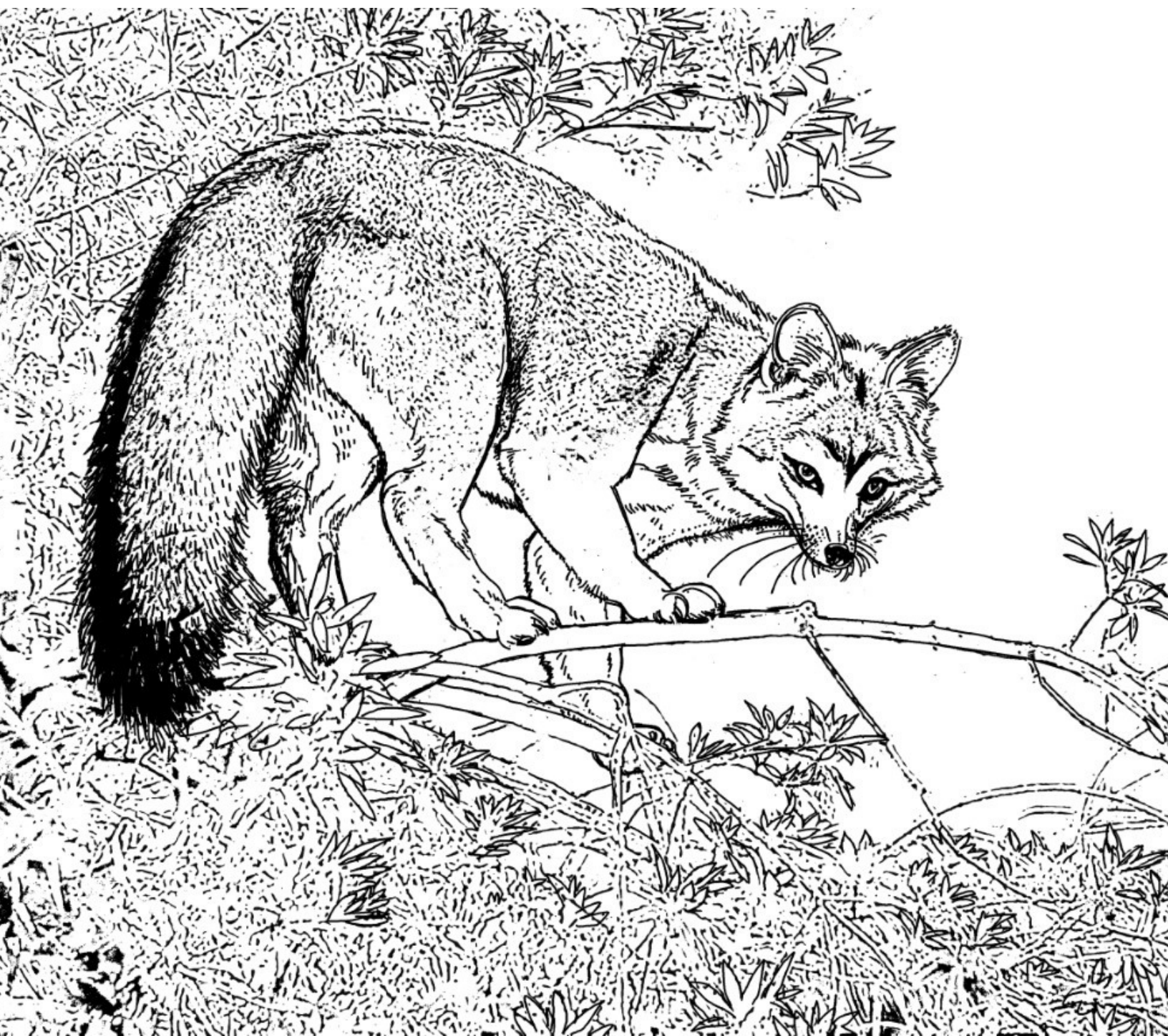
COLOR THE COYOTE



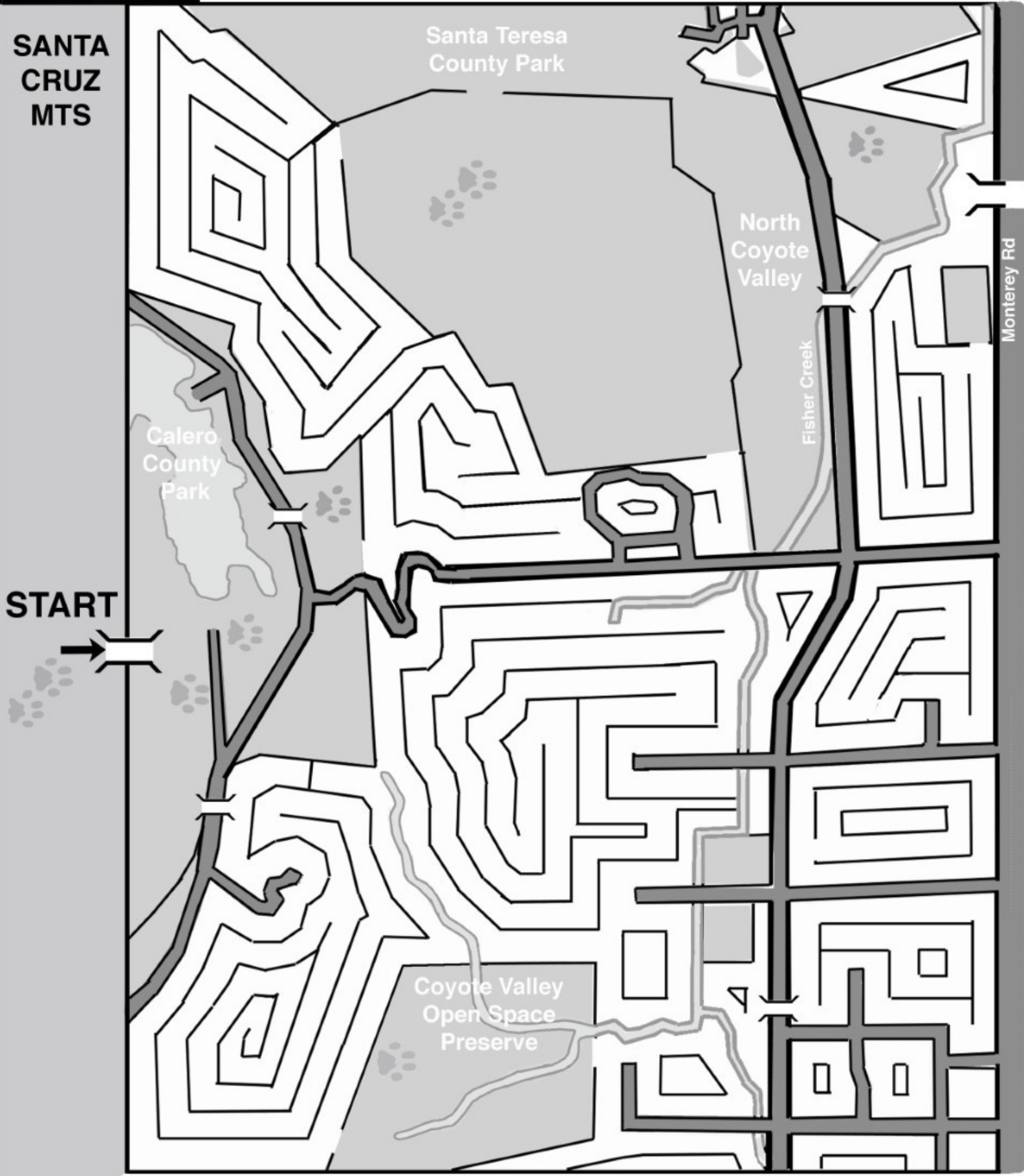
Coyotes weigh 20 to 50 pounds and are active around sunrise and sunset.

They are very good at climbing trees.



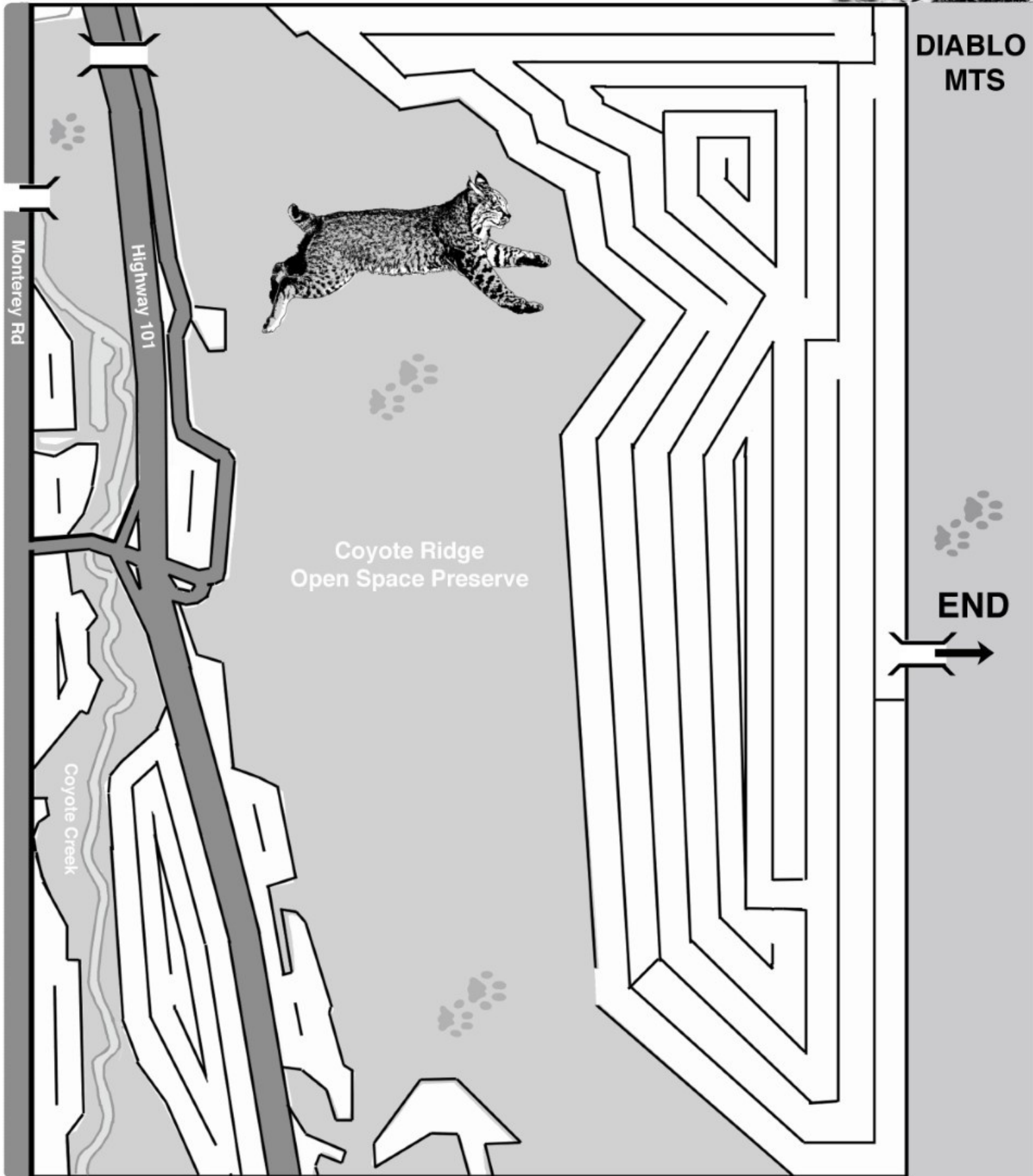
Bobcats can safely cross all creeks, bridges, open spaces and county parks.

Move safely from the Santa Cruz Mts to the Diablo Mts

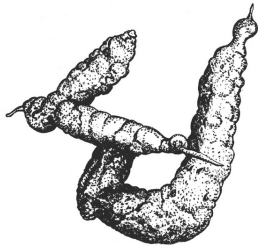
Bobcats can't safely cross the roads unless there is a crossing.



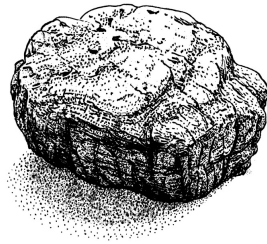
**You cannot cross black lines.

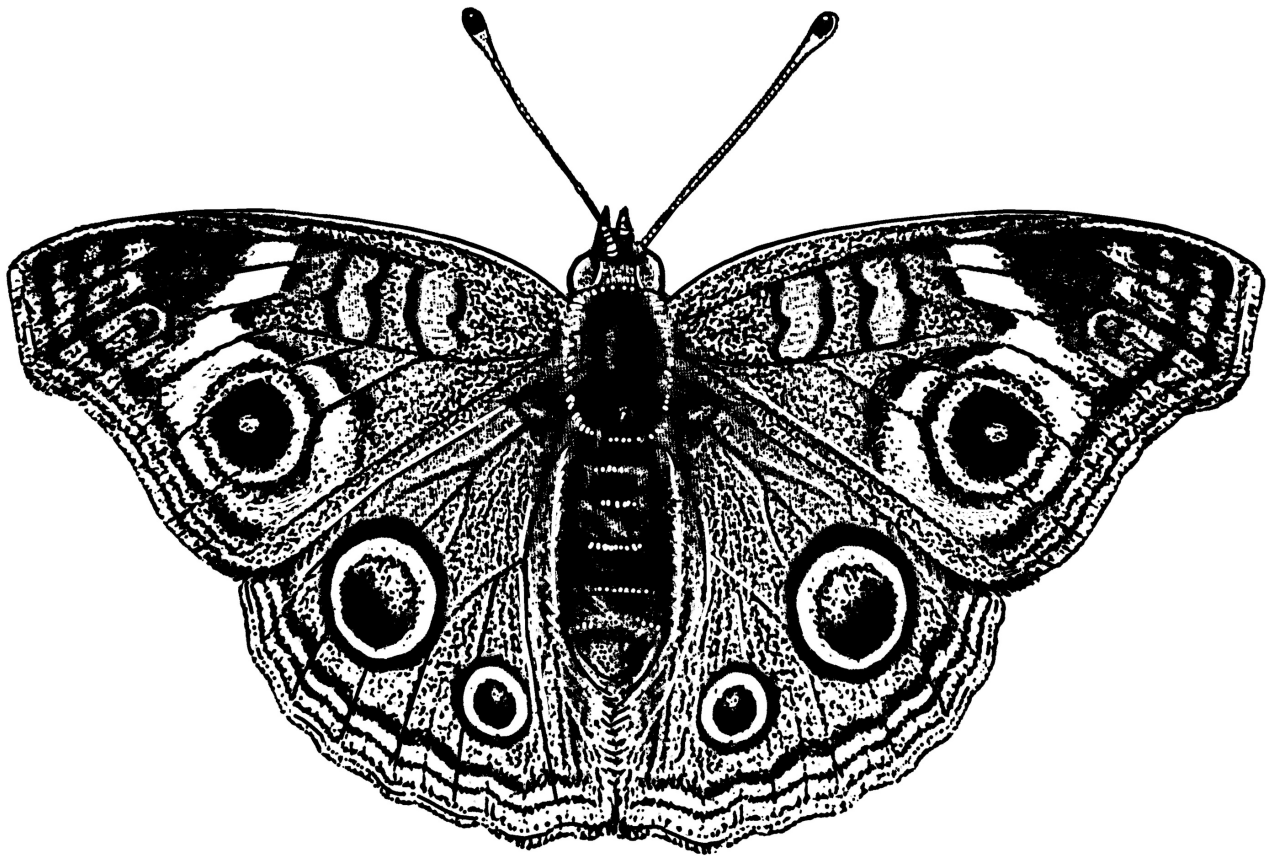
